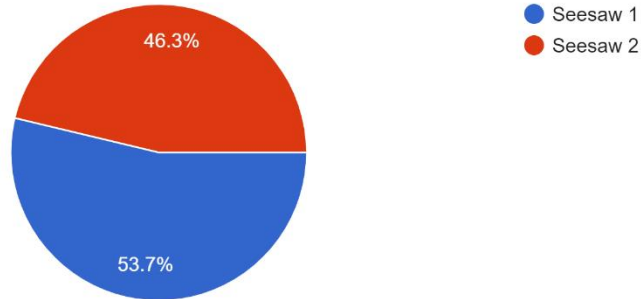
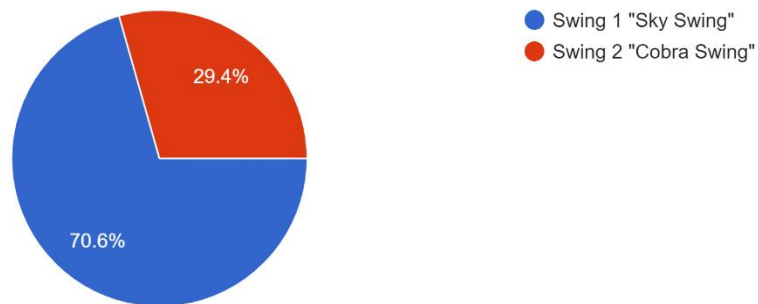


Playground Consultation Summary

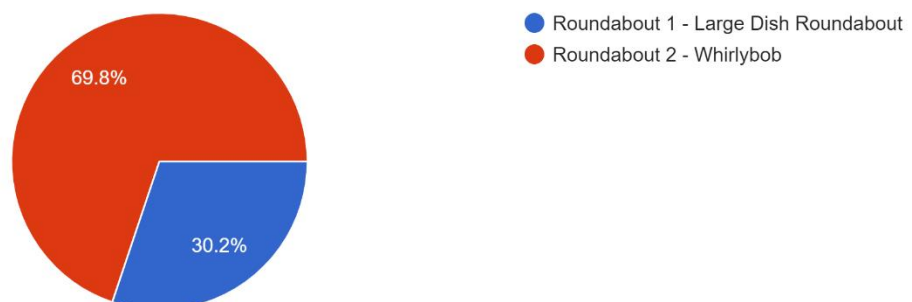
Which Seesaw type do you prefer?



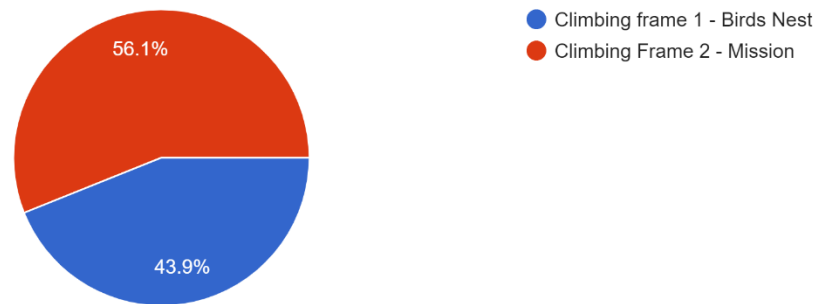
Which Swing do you prefer?
