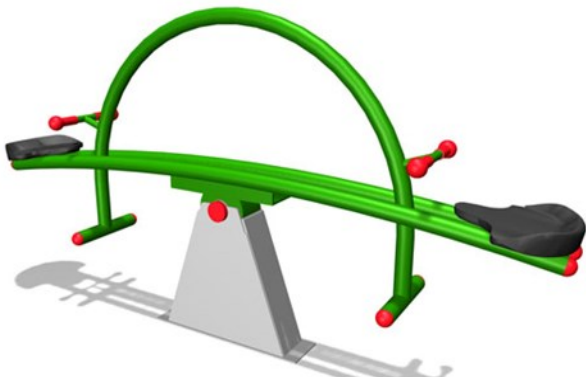


FILLONGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

PLAYGROUND CONSULTATION

FPC are trying to source funding for new play equipment at the park in Church Lane. We would be interested to have your opinions and your votes. Please decide which of these STYLE of equipment you would prefer, bearing in mind your own preferences and also what is already provided at the park. The Council feel that there is less available at the moment for older children and are keen to fill that gap but it is up to you!

All of this depends on successful funding applications. FPC are also looking at the viability of repairing the existing roundabout and keeping that, and the viability of changing the swing seats for more modern alternatives or replacing the swings completely. This would be in addition to the suggestions below.



Seesaw 1

A traditional style “rocker” seesaw designed for 2 children



Or

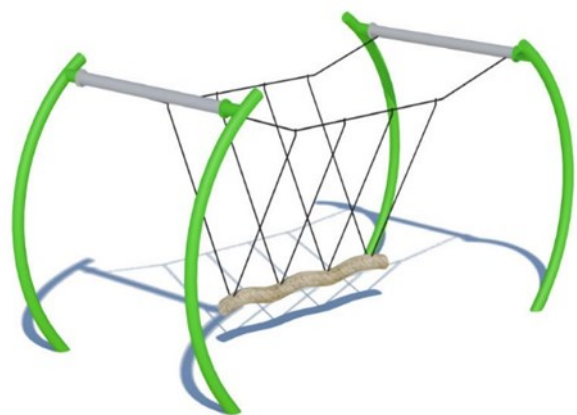
Seesaw 2

A springer “bouncing” type seesaw designed for up to 6 children



Swing 1 “Sky Swing”

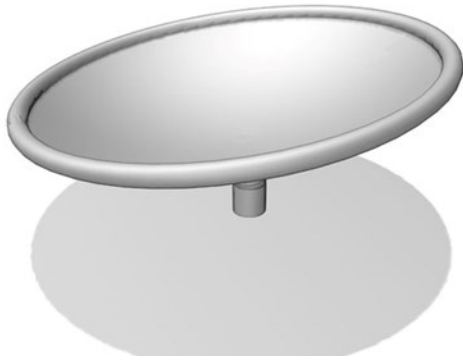
Spins as well as swings, designed for up to 3 children



Or

Swing 2 “Cobra Swing”

Pendulum type swing designed for groups of up to 6 children



Roundabout 1 - Large Dish Roundabout
Spins, designed so that children can sit inside it or around the edge. Multiple children Age 3—14 years

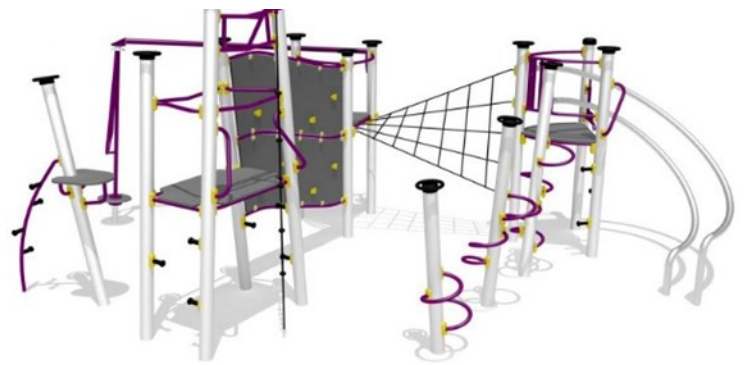


Or Roundabout 2 - Whirlybob
Designed to sit and spin all the way round. For up to 4 children aged 2—8 years



Climbing frame 1—Birds Nest

A more traditional climbing design; slide height , 1.75m. Nests are 2.2m high and additional climbing



OR

Climbing frame 2—Mission

A more modern interpretative design, “slide (poles) height at 1.6m high, platforms are 1.5m and climbing wall height of 2.5m.

Both these exact climbing frames may prove to be a bit beyond budget BUT which style do you prefer? What other attributes should a good climbing frame have? We are keeping the existing climbing frame so the new one is aimed at older /more adventurous children. Please let us know your thoughts.
