REASON FOR INQUIRY

Appeal by Enviromena Project Management UK Ltd, relating to the application to North Warwickshire Borough Council for Construction of a temporary Solar Farm, to include the installation of ground-mounted solar panels together with associated works, equipment and necessary infrastructure, at Land 800 Metres South of Park House Farm, Meriden Road, Fillongley, CV7 8BP.

An Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State will hold an Inquiry opening on the date shown above to decide the appeal.

Members of the public may attend the Inquiry and, at the Inspector's discretion, express their views.
