

Minutes of the Meeting of Fillongley Parish Council Held at Fillongley Village Hall on Thursday 20th November 2025 at 7.30pm

Present: Cllr A R Pargetter, Cllr A B White, Cllr S Onions, Cllr J Hooke, Cllr D Wardley and Cllr P Sullivan. Clerk: Cllrs Sullivan and Wardley. There were 10 members of the public in attendance.

14304 AGENDA ITEM 1 APOLOGIES

There were Apologies received from NWBC Cllrs Mark Simpson and David Wright.

14305 AGENDA ITEM 2 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

The Chairman invited members who wished to do so to make declaration of pecuniary and non-pecuniary interest in respect of items on the agenda. None were declared.

14306 AGENDA ITEM 3 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS

Minutes of the previous Council meeting held on Thursday 17th October 2025 and the Minutes of the HR committee meeting on 4th November, having been previously circulated and read, were approved on the proposition of Cllr White and Seconded by Cllr Onions. All in favour.

14307 AGENDA ITEM 4 PUBLIC DISCUSSION

Meeting Closed. There was public discussion regarding the following;

- Flooding in the village; what is to be done for local properties in the village? The current emergency plan needs updating. Rachel Taylor MP has been notified of issues.

14308 AGENDA ITEM 5 PROGRESS REPORTS for information

- Change of speed limit in Wood End Lane.** No progress in reducing the limit. WCC are happy with it being National Speed Limit.
- Road marking on Coventry Road.** Not completed. WCC will look at it when the weather improves, possibly in the spring.
- Trip rail/bund proposal.** No progress.
- Football changing rooms update (architect/planapp)** Waiting for response from architect. There has been a verbal conversation with the Scouting group who are suggesting merging the changing rooms and scouting buildings and leaving the existing changing rooms as a storage building. There is no further written suggestion at this stage. Noted.
- Speed surveys on Nuneaton Road, Meriden Road and Church Lane.** Not completed.
- Footpath on Tamworth Road.** The gully is cleared.
- Japanese Knotweed reported.** No progress as it is the wrong time of year.
- FNP inspection.** No further progress.
- Fillongley Crossroads.** WCC Cllr Scott Cameron reported that there are clear objections to traffic lights at the crossroads. WCC Cllr Jennifer Warren has agreed in principal to install traffic lights despite local objection. A crossing is also proposed although it is not clear where this will be (Coventry Road/Nuneaton Road). Cllr Sullivan suggested that temporary lights could be set up for a month to see the effects.

- j. **Repairs to footpath sleepers on Corley Moor.** No progress.
- k. **Newhall Green potholes.** No progress.
- l. **Damaged height restriction barrier at the park.** Lower price was received of £525 so Clerk has authorised the work as per the last meeting. In addition, there is a small repair to the tractor which has also been requested.
- m. **Little Oaks court case.** Cost was agreed in the last meeting however Clerk has not had time to progress.
- n. **Banking changes.** These will be completed after this meeting.
- o. **Loose dogs on Hardingwood Lane.** Police attended but house empty so will return.
- p. **Remembrance Sunday.** Thanks to all involved in organising and those who attended.
- q. **WALC AGM.** Cllr Pargetter attended the online meeting although the communications were poor and he couldn't clearly hear the presentations.
- r. **Consultation on removal of Garages in Eastlang Road.** There has been consultation on removal of NWBC garages but those in Eastlang Road were not included. Clerk trying to ascertain why, but no response to date.
